The Building Safety Regulator can now ask you to apply for your Building Assessment Certificate since legislation was introduced on April 1st 2024.

 - ✓ Fire Strategy
- FRAEW (and other external building assessments)
- Mandatory Occurrence Report Policy
- Resident Engagement Strategy
 - ✓ Fire Door Surveys

Gateway 1 (Planning Gateway)

Gateway 1 ensures **Fire Safety** consideration at the earliest stage.

Approval process is through HSE not the BSR

It requires a Fire Statement to support the planning application.

This must be completed by a suitably qualified company / individual.

London projects may require a London Plan (GLA) fire statement too.

PAPs & APs

Principal Accountable Person:
Holds a legal estate in relevant

parts of the structure & exterior.

Accountable Person: Holds a legal estate in possession of any part of the common parts or repairs obligation in any part.

Gateway 2 (Before Construction)

Gateway 2 comes at the end of the design stage (RIBA Stage 4)

Applications must be submitted to the BSR, that include (but is not limited to):

Competency declaration

Description of work & plans.

Construction Control Plan

Design and Build Approach

Maintenance arrangement for The Golden Thread

If applicable - details of proposed partial completion strategy.

The BSR has 12 weeks to approve or reject applications.

Construction CANNOT commence until Gateway 2 approval has been received.

Gateway 3 (Post Construction)

Gateway 3 takes place at completion, RIBA stage 6.

BSR Approval is needed before a **Completion Certificate** can be issued.

The Gateway 3 application must include (but is not limited to:

As-built final drawings

Compliance Statement

Construction Control Plan

Change Control Plan

Mandatory Occurrence Reporting Plan


Confirmation of Regulation 38

The BSR has 8 weeks to approve or reject the application.
